# **ABOUT GFAP**

#### Background

As VinUni CHS grows, our three flagship programs (UME, UNE, and GME) will continuously be in need of dedicated, skilled, and diverse faculty to contribute to our trainees' opportunities for teaching, mentorship, career advising and research collaboration. While in just a few short years since VinUni's inception we have cultivated dozens of meaningful institutional partnerships locally (e.g. Vinmec Health System, Military 108 Central Hospital, National Children's Hospital, and others), nationally (Ho Chi Minh City UMP), regionally and globally, there remains a need to increase the number of experts on our adjunct faculty. This is particularly true for certain specialty areas that are not as well established in Vietnam as elsewhere, or for certain areas of research. We currently have an opportunity to fill this gap through the model called the Global Faculty Affiliates Program (GFAP).



# **ABOUT GFAP**

#### Concept

Global Faculty Affiliates are faculty appointed by VinUni under a special adjunct series that does not come with salary support, but does offer other benefits in return for a defined role in supporting our trainees. GFAP faculty are typically based outside of Vietnam, have a demonstrated expertise in at least one of the following areas: medical/ nursing/ public health education, subspecialty training, or impactful research, and have a passion to make a meaningful contribution to VinUni CHS' overall vision and mission. Although most GFAP faculty will be current faculty at another institution of higher learning, this will not be an absolute requirement. For example, a medical educator who works in government, industry, or the non-profit sector may be an excellent GFAP candidate. If GFAP faculty are already appointed faculty at another institution, then VinUni would recognize their achievement and appoint them at the same rank. Appointments would be made for 2 years, and renewable upon request if the faculty is in good standing.

For GFAP faculty who plan to spend at least 2 weeks onsite teaching, there may be support possible for economy airfare and travel accommodation.








# VIETNAMESE SIM CARD

#### Getting a Vietnamese SIM Instruction

#### 1. Arrival at Vietnam

Once you arrive at the airport, you'll find SIM card kiosks from the major mobile service providers: Viettel, MobiFone, and Vinaphone. These are the top three mobile carriers in Vietnam, and they offer various prepaid plans for tourists



#### 2. What You'll Need

- Passport: In Vietnam, it's required for foreigners to show their passport when buying a SIM card. Make sure you have it handy.
- Payment: You can pay for the SIM card and the plan with cash or credit/debit cards. It's usually more convenient to pay in cash.

#### 3. Choosing a Plan

You'll have several options depending on your data and call needs. For tourists, it's common to go for data-only plans, but if you need local calls or international calls, there are plans that include those as well. Some carriers also offer "tourist packages" that last 30 days.

For example:

Viettel: Known for good coverage and fast data speeds.

MobiFone: Has reasonable prices and decent coverage in cities.

Vinaphone: Offers some of the most competitive rates, especially

for data

# TRANSPORTATION

#### How to get a TAXI in Vietnam?

• Using Apps (Grab/Gojek)

Grab is an popular app for taxis, motorbikes, and more. Download the app, set up payment, and book a ride.

- Gojek is another option, similar to Grab.
- Traditional Taxis

Look for reliable brands like Vinasun or Mai Linh. Always check the meter is on.

VinFast Xanh SM

For an eco-friendly ride, use the VinFast Xanh SM service. Book through the Xanh SM app for a modern electric car, motorbikes.

If you're heading to VinUni campus, you **must** use VinFast Xanh SM electric taxis for an eco-friendly and convenient ride. This service is specifically designated for travel within and around VinUni's Ocean Park campus.





## REIMBURSEMENT

#### **Policy**

At VinUniversity, we follow **specific cost norms** for airfare and accommodation **based on the region** where the guest is traveling from.

cool breeze and dry atmosphere.





# Is there a washing machine for laundry and iron in the apartment?

Yes, the hotel offers laundry services for a fee. And there are a lot of laundry shops in Ocean Park for you to choose.

#### Does fabric include towels etc?

Yes. There are towels in your apartment. Please kindly ask the receptionist if you can not find towels in your room.

#### Are there any hospitals or clinics nearby?

Our Vinmec Times City is about 12km away from Ocean Park.

#### Is it customary to tip in Vietnam?

Tipping is not mandatory in Vietnam but is appreciated. In restaurants, rounding up the bill or leaving a small tip (5-10% of the total) is a kind gesture. Tipping is also common for hotel staff or tour guides

Most international credit cards (Visa, MasterCard) are accepted at major hotels, shopping malls, and restaurants in Vietnam. However, smaller shops or street vendors may only accept cash, so it's a good idea to carry some local currency.
