

AHA'S ADVANCED CARDIAC LIFE SUPPORT (ACLS) PROVIDER COURSE



Certification:

After completing a written and practical test, participants will receive an AHA ACLS provider certificate with 2-year validity.



Who should take this course?

Healthcare professionals who either direct or participate in the management of cardiopulmonary arrest or other cardiovascular emergencies, including physicians, nurses, paramedics, respiratory therapists, pharmacists and others as required by their employers.





Course duration:

- ACLS Provider Course: 2.5 days
- ACLS Provider Renewal: 1.5 days

*** ACLS Provider Renewal is for participants who still have a valid AHA's ACLS card in their possession on the day of the class.



Material: Learners will be delivered official AHA's ACLS Provider Manual



Course content:

- High-quality BLS, including early chest compressions and early automated external defibrillator (AED) use
- Recognition and early management of respiratory arrest, acute coronary syndromes (ACS), stroke, bradyarrhythmias, tachyarrhythmias and cardiac arrest until termination of resuscitation or transfer of care, including immediate post-cardiac arrest care
- Effective communication as a member and leader of a high-performing team.

Bilingual in English and Vietnamese with all teaching materials and videos in English.
